Information on data protection in accordance with Art. 13 and 14 GDPR

Data protection is important to us. We would like to inform you below about the use of your data by Amprion Offshore GmbH.

1. Data controller

3. Scope of the processing of personal data

As an independent transmission system operator, Amprion plans, builds and operates transmission systems in the electricity sector to fulfil the statutory mandates for grid expansion and grid operation. Amprion Offshore GmbH plans and constructs the associated offshore grid integration systems on behalf of Amprion GmbH and is responsible for their system operation. We collect and use your personal data only insofar as is necessary to carry out our business tasks. The personal data are categorised as follows, for example:

Data category	Example
Personal master data	Salutation, name, title and date of birth
Communication and contact details	Email address, telephone number, address
Contract partner details	Company, sector, position, Contact
Contract master data	Contract number, start/end of contract, contract type, contract status
Payment transaction data	Account/credit card number, IBAN, payment reference, transaction data
Other data	Parcel data

4. Sources of personal data

Sources of personal data may, for example, be commercial data portals (data services of data providers), land consolidation authorities, land registry offices, registration offices, tax offices and land registries.

5. Legal bases for the purposes of data processing

Processing personal data always requires a legal basis for authorised data processing. The processing purposes listed in the table below are intended merely as examples. Additional processing information may be provided for specific processing purposes, which is then applicable. The following legal bases must be observed for our processing purposes:

Legal basis	Processing purpose (List of purposes by way of example)
<u>Consent:</u> Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR	Consent to use cookies requiring consent
<u>Performance of a contract or implementation of pre-contractual measures:</u> Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR	Contracts are archived for the performance of a contract
<u>Compliance with a legal obligation:</u> Art. 6(1)(c) GDPR	Processing personal data in connection with public building projects
<u>Processing is necessary in order to protect the vital interests of the data subject or of another individual:</u> Art. 6(1)(d) GDPR	Processing personal data to safeguard occupational safety, e.g. to contain deadly diseases (fighting a pandemic)
<u>Processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller:</u> Art. 6(1)(e) GDPR	Processing personal data in the context of providing public services
<u>Processing is necessary to safeguard the legitimate interests of the controller or of a third party:</u> Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR	Processing personal data in the context of video surveillance to safeguard house rules, to detect unauthorised access and to collect evidence
<u>Processing specific categories of personal data:</u> Amprion Offshore GmbH does not process specific categories of personal data within the meaning of Art. 9(1) GDPR. However, should this be necessary in individual cases, they are processed exclusively in accordance with Art. 9(2) GDPR.	Processing data on political opinions, such as party affiliation

6. Recipients of personal data

Within our company, access to data is granted to those individuals who need it to fulfil the above-mentioned purposes. This also applies to service providers and vicarious agents deployed by us. We only transmit personal data to third parties if this is necessary for the aforementioned purposes or if you have given your consent beforehand. Processors are involved in accordance with the provisions of Art. 28 GDPR.

Recipients of personal data may, for example, be planning and engineering offices, surveyors, construction companies, authorities, courts, notary's offices and grid operators.

7. Transfer to a third country

Should data be transferred to a third country, this is carried out in accordance with the relevant data protection requirements of Chapter 5 GDPR. If such a transfer to a third country is envisaged in your specific case, you will be notified accordingly, stating the guarantees and protection measures taken.

8. Duration of data storage

Your personal data will be deleted as soon as the storage purpose no longer applies. Data may also be stored if this has been provided for by the European or national legislator in EU regulations, laws or other provisions to which we are subject as controller. Data may also be deleted if a storage period prescribed by the said standards expires, unless there is a need to continue storing the data for the conclusion or performance of a contract.

9. Right of access, right to rectification, restriction of processing, deletion, objection to and revocation of consent

You are entitled to be informed about the personal data stored about you, their origin and recipients as well as the purpose of storage. You may request the rectification or deletion or the restriction of the processing of your data if the data are factually incorrect or their processing is not (or no longer) permissible. You may also be entitled to the restriction of processing if Amprion Offshore GmbH no longer requires the data but you need these data to assert, exercise or defend legal claims. If we process your data on the basis of balancing interests, you are entitled to object to the processing thereof. You are entitled to withdraw your declaration of consent under data protection law at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of the processing thereof based on consent before it is withdrawn.

You are also entitled to data portability. Please use the contact details listed under No. 12 to exercise your rights.

10. Right of appeal to a supervisory authority

Without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy, you are entitled to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, in particular in the Member State of your habitual residence, place of work or place of the alleged infringement, if you consider that the processing of personal data relating to you infringes the GDPR.
